Finn Kjær Jensen is responsible for strategic management, its research and the day-to-day operations of the institute. Finn Kjær Jensen functions as an expert on social and theoretical risk problems. Finn Kjær Jensen has been participating in the establishment of PRIMO Denmark and PRIMO Europe, respectively a risk management association for public sector chief executives in Denmark and the pan-European umbrella association. Today, PRIMO Europe has local organisations in France, Netherlands, Belgium, Sweden, Poland, Malta and Cyprus. Finn Kjær Jensen's work in the construction of PRIMO Denmark was recognised when EIRM was awarded the prestigious Strategic Risk *Risk Management Service Provider of the Year* in 2008.

Additionally, Finn Kjær Jensen has been responsible for the creation and development of the concept of risk leadership. The publication of the document, *Risikoledelse (Risk Leadership Standard)*, with a preface by the then Minister of Home Affairs and Minister of Health under his guidance gained ground within the Danish public sector.

Prior coming to EIRM, Finn Kjær Jensen held roles as Chief of Development in a Danish county and served as Head of Education at a university hospital in Copenhagen.

He is an anthropologist by training and has been a research fellow at The Institute of Anthropology in Copenhagen, as well as an Assistant Professor for External Examination at several universities in Denmark. He has done research on cultural and social perception of risk, social movements, charismatic leadership, collective memory, and the history of science. He has extensive fieldwork experience in Latin America and Saudi Arabia.
